Weaned Calf Protection

A new cattle risk management product is on the horizon in Nebraska, Texas, Colorado, and South Dakota: Weaned Calf Revenue Protection (WCRP). This new policy will provide federally subsidized revenue protection for the decline in price and lost yield in the form of decreased overall weaning weight per third-party confirmed weaning weight. The release is slated for this fall for the 2024 crop year.

USDA Previews Emergency Relief Assistance for Agricultural Producers Who Incurred Losses Due to 2022 Natural Disaster Events

Agriculture Secretary, Tom Vilsack, announced plans to roll out \$3.7 billion in Emergency Relief Program (ERP) and Emergency Livestock Relief Program (ELRP) assistance, to crop and livestock producers who sustained losses due to a qualifying natural disaster event in calendar year 2022. USDA is sharing early information to allow producers time to gather documents in advance of program delivery. Through distribution of remaining funds, USDA is also concluding the 2021 ELRP program by sending payments in the amount of 20% of the initial ELRP payment to all existing recipients.

The Annual Forage policy has had some significant changes this year. We will be reaching out to all of you before July 15th to help make those changes!

USDA Expands Margin Protection

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is expanding its Margin Protection insurance plan, adding more than a thousand counties to the insurance option that provides coverage against an unexpected decrease in operating margin for corn and soybean producers. This expansion, which is in direct response to growing interest among producers, will be available by June 30, 2023. If interested, you will need to purchase your coverage by Sept. 30, 2023, to be eligible for the 2024 crop year.

Important Dates

- <u>June 1st June 30st 2023 Wheat harvest price measurement off the July KCBT board.</u>
- July 1st Final date to make changes or to transfer existing policy to FARM Inc. for DRP,
 LRP and LGM policies. Premium billing date for fall crops.
- July 15th Acreage reporting date for spring crops (beans, corn, grain sorghum and spring wheat) and Annual Forage growing season 4. Final date to sign up or make changes to the 2024 Annual Forage policies.
- August 15th Premium billing date for spring crops.
- August 30th Premium billing date for annual forage policies.
- September 1st Premium billing date for PRF policies.
- September 30th Final date to make changes or add coverage to your fall crops.
- December 1st Final date to sign up or make changes to PRF policies and acreage reporting deadline for PRF.
