Deadline: March 15, 2024

There is a lot of interaction that occurs between the ARC and PLC decisions with FSA and how they relate to ECO/SCO and your insurance coverage. The FSA reference price will be higher in 2024 for Corn and Soybeans but will remain the same for Wheat.

Important Dates to add to your Calendar.

- Annual Forage Acreage reporting date is based on the month they are planted and must be reported by the 5th day of the month following the planting.
- <u>February 1st February 29th</u> Corn insurance initial price measured using 2024
 DEC. board and soybean insurance initial price measured using 2024 NOV.
 board.
- March 15th Final date to sign up or make changes to spring policies. Deadline
 to sign up for 2024 crop year ARC/PLC program at FSA. Final date to short rate
 wheat acres. No grazing after this date if taking to harvest for grain.
- April 29th Production reporting deadline for spring crops.
