# Information needed for the 2026 Pasture, Rangeland, Forage (PRF), and Apiculture (API) policies.

**Keminder: 2026 PRF & API Sales Closing Coming Up!** 

The sales closing date for the 2026 PRF and API policy year is just around the corner! This year, we are required to collect your lease agreements and/or proof of ownership for acreage reporting. To stay compliant and avoid delays, we will need all documents submitted by December 1st. Please reach out to your agent soon to ensure everything is in order. Thanks for staying ahead of the deadline!

- If you enrolled in Phase 1 of the **Emergency Commodity** Assistance Program (ECAP), keep an eye out for your Phase 2 payments.

## **Important Dates**

<u>Annual Forage</u> – Acreage reporting date is based on the month they are planted and must be reported by the 5th day of the month following the planting.

<u>August 15th – September 14<sup>th</sup> – Projected wheat price is being measured off JUL 2026 KCBT board.</u>

<u>September 15<sup>th</sup> – Final date to lock in an endorsement for Q4 of 2025 for DRP policies.</u>

<u>September 30<sup>th</sup></u> Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverage to your fall crops including wheat and triticale. Remember to pay your PRF/API premium by this date; after that interest will begin to accrue.

October 1st - October 31st - Harvest prices are measured for cotton off DEC board.

November 1st - November 30st - Harvest prices for OK cotton measured off DEC board.

November 14<sup>th</sup> – Production reporting deadline for 2025 harvested wheat.

November 30th - Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverage to potato policies in TX.

<u>December 1st –</u> Final date to sign up and/or make entity/interval changes to PRF Rainfall Index policies. Acreage reporting deadline for PRF Rainfall Index policies.
