🔔 Reminder: 2026 PRF & API Sales Closing Coming Up!

The sales closing date for the 2026 PRF and API policy year is just around the corner! This year, **we are required to collect your lease agreements and/or proof of ownership** for acreage reporting. To stay compliant and avoid delays, we will need **all documents submitted by December 1st**. Please reach out to your agent soon to ensure everything is in order. Thanks for staying ahead of the deadline!

Important Dates

September 30th – Final date to make changes or add coverage to your onion policy. Also, the final date to make changes or add coverage to forage production policies in AZ. Remember to pay your PRF/API premium by this date; after that interest will begin to accrue.

October 1st - October 31st – Harvest prices are measured for cotton and corn off DEC board.

October 31st – Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverages to your fall crops including wheat, barley, and garbanzo beans. Also, the final date to add/make changes on triticale in Yuma County.

November 20th – Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverage to citrus policies.

November 30th – Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverage to potato policies in AZ.

December 1st – Final date to sign up or make entity and/or interval changes to PRF/API Rainfall Index policies and the acreage reporting deadline for PRF/API Rainfall Index policies.

December 15th – Fall production reporting deadline including wheat and barley. Also, final date to lock in an endorsement for Q1 of 2026 for DRP policies.

December 31st – Final date to make entity changes and/or add coverage to almond and pistachio policies.

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
