#### **ERP Phase II**

The Emergency Relief Program (ERP) Phase 2 has been announced. Phase 1 leveraged existing Federal Crop Insurance or Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) data that was the basis for calculating initial payments. Now Phase 2 intends to fill additional gaps for the producers who **did not** participate in existing risk management programs. Phase 2 will be a tax year based system and will provide assistance to producers that suffered a loss in revenue due in whole or part, to a qualifying disaster in the 2020 or 2021 calendar years. For more information you will need to contact your local FSA office.

## Pandemic Assistance Revenue Program (PARP)

The PARP program is a USDA program intended to support producers who have been impacted by the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. PARP will provide direct financial assistance to producers of agricultural commodities who have suffered at least a 15% loss in "Gross" revenue in the 2020 calendar year due to COVID-19. Eligible commodities include a crop, aquaculture, livestock, livestock byproduct, or other animal or animal byproduct that is produced as part of a farming operation and intends to be marketed commercially. Eligible producers can apply by filling out a FSA-1122 PARP form and submitting it to your local FSA office.

### **Livestock Risk Protection**

We have had a lot of success recently with the LRP Program. As a reminder, those who have had an endorsement end recently, we have 60 days to finalize your claim and show proof of cattle ownership. Please reach out to our office if you have any questions or if there is anything we can do to help get you a check in the mail! ## Important Dates - West Texas & Oklahoma



- January 15<sup>th</sup> Acreage reporting date for Annual Forage Growing Season 2. Acreage reporting date for fall crops.
- <u>February 1<sup>st</sup> February 29<sup>th</sup></u> Corn and cotton insurance initial price measured using 2023 DEC.
  board.
- March 15<sup>th</sup> Final date to sign up or make changes to spring policies. Deadline to sign up for 2023 crop year ARC/PLC program at FSA.
- April 1<sup>st</sup> Final date to short rate wheat acres. No grazing after this date if taking to harvest for grain.
- April 15<sup>th</sup> Final plant date and acreage reporting date for Annual Forage Growing Season 3.
- April 29<sup>th</sup> Production reporting deadline for spring crops.

Other Texas regions may have earlier reporting dates. Contact us for the dates for your area.
